



European Scout Committee
Record of Key Decisions – June 2023

Following its third Business Meeting held in June 2023, the European Scout Committee (ESCttee):

- Confirmed the appointment of Bo Holmström, Treasurer for the European Scout Region - formally as of June 2023, to the Board of the European Scout Foundation as per the ESC Standing Orders 2022-2025 (Section 3 - item 3.1) reflecting the Statutes of the European Scout Foundation (the Chapter II - Article 6).
- Approved the final list of key items requiring attention and follow-up as part of the transition to the New Geographical Boundaries of the European Scout Region.
- Discussed the effects, influences, and opportunities and agreed on internal indicators for the success of the New Geographical Boundaries by 2028:
 - Growing Strong Organizations: focused on minimum standards to be identified with each MOs in the areas of Youth Programme, Adults in Scouting, Good Governance and Safe from Harm.
 - Investing in Growth and Membership Development
 - Building continued participation in the life of the Region
 - Championing Networks: providing guidance to MOs on those opportunities for success.
- Confirmed Committee Contact distribution for those MOs joining the European Scout Region:

- Agreed to organise a European Networking event in Autumn 2024 (24-26 November 2023) in Budapest, Hungary.
- Approved the Terms of Reference of an Advisory Board to support our plans forward with the New Geographical Boundaries. This Team will be recruited through targeted recruitment.
- Approved the Regional Budget 2023-2024.
- Adopted a plan for implementing Safe from Harm in the European Scout Region.
