**APR Workshop on Fundraising**

We are happy to announce that the Asia-Pacific Region is organizing the APR Workshop on Fundraising together with our host NSO, The General Association of the Scouts of China. This workshop, being part of the APR Plan 2022-2025 under the Governance strategic priority with the objective of building capacity in Resources Development and Financial Management enhancing NSOs financial sustainability.

This workshop will be another learning opportunity and sharing NSOs best practice in the area of Fundraising.

Details of the workshop are as follows:

**Dates:** 17-19 October 2024, arrival on 16<sup>th</sup> afternoon and departure on 20<sup>th</sup> morning until noon.

**Delivery Mode and Venue:** In-person at Spring City Resort, Taipei City

**Registration Fee:** USD200.00 per participant to cover accommodation (twin sharing), food for the workshop duration, airport reception, transfer from airport to venue and back, and materials.

**Aim and Learning Objectives**

The aim of this workshop is to help leaders understand the basic principles of fundraising, gain knowledge and skills in fundraising and able to apply in respective NSOs to raise funds locally.

At the end of the workshop, participants will be able to:


1. Identify various fundraising opportunities available within and around NSO (strengthening knowledge)
