

APR Workshop on Fundraising

General Information

Aim:

The aim of this workshop is to help leaders understand the basic principles of fundraising, gain knowledge and skills in fundraising and able to apply in respective NSOs to raise funds locally

Objectives:

- Identify various fundraising opportunities available within and around NSO (strengthening knowledge)
- Illustrate best practices on Fundraising in member National Scout Organizations.
- Define methods, techniques and tools for effective planning and implementation of fundraising projects.
- Draft fundraising projects based on the learnings during the Workshop

Date and Duration:

17 - 19 October 2024

Participants are expected to arrive on 16 October, afternoon until evening and may depart on 20 October noon. It is highly encouraged to avoid arriving/ departing in the late hours and early morning in consideration of the airport reception/ local transportation team.

Participants:

This workshop is proposed to gather 40 key leaders (Partnership, Resources Development and Management, etc) of the NSO.

Registration Fee:

USD200.00 which covers inland transport, food (from dinner on 16 October to lunch on 20 October) and accommodation during the event (check-in on 16 October and check out on 20 October), workshop materials.

APR Fundraising Dinner:

The Asia- Pacific Regional Scout Foundation is organizing a Fundraising Dinner on 19 October 2024 at 1830hrs at Spring City Resort. All participants are invited to attend the dinner by contributing to the APR Scout Foundation (ticket cost USD100), and an opportunity to experience how a Fundraising Dinner is organized.

Airport Reception:

Participants will be met by TGASC Scouts at Taoyuan International Airport (TPE) and will be transported to the venue. For easy recognition, it is expected that participants arrive in uniform or at least wear the scarf. Please ensure to send your itinerary well in advance to TGASC with a copy to us.

Accommodation:

Accommodation will start from 16th October, night until 19th October, night (4 nights) in twin sharing rooms.

Visa:

Travel Insurance:

It is highly recommended to secure travel insurance in any regional/ international events. Please ensure to purchase travel insurance locally.

Working Language:

The working language of the workshop is English. Participants must be able to understand and take an active part in the discussions in English.

Weather:

Taiwan weather in October gets cooler and cooler, with the average temperature of around 21 - 27°C (70 - 81°F). There are some rains and showers in October in Taiwan, and the most of rains fall in the northern area including Taipei, Keelung and Yilan, and Taitung and Hualien in the east and mountain areas. It is quite clear in the middle and southern places.

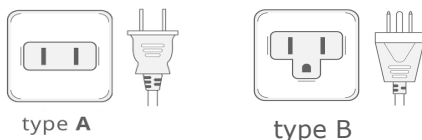
With the start of the cold weather, light clothing still works and a light sweater or coat. It is recommended to always carry a small umbrella.

Currency:

NTD is the official currency, current conversion to USD1.00 is around TWD32.35 (as of 05 June 2024). Credit cards are widely accepted throughout the country. It is highly recommended to change your money at the airport if you do not have credit card.

Electricity:

Taipei has the same electrical standard as the US and Canada: 110V, 60Hz AC. Electrical sockets have two vertical slots.

**Personal gear to bring:**

Scout uniform, personal clothing, personal medicines, jacket/ coat, and personal toiletries.
