We understand that bidding candidates for World Events must complete a [GSAT assessment](#) as part of the process.

We will complete a feasibility report based on the World Scout Bureau's technical questionnaire to complement the preliminary visit of the World Scout Bureau.

We understand that our final bid documentation must be received by 31 July and this along with conclusions from the visit and a review of the feasibility report will be presented by the World Scout Bureau to the World Scout Committee.
