

**European Scout Committee  
Record of Key Decisions – June 2025**

Since its Eighth Business Meeting held in March 2025 and following its Ninth Business Meeting held in June 2025, the European Scout Committee:

- Approved the Budget for the year 2025-2026.
- Reviewed the financial analysis of the recently approved [Roadmap Towards Decarbonisation](#) and approved the implementation plan for year 1.
- In line with its mandate to appoint members of the Regional Safe from Harm Panel, Gordon Weston (UK) was appointed, acknowledging the value of expertise in safeguarding and his long-standing contributions to child protection in the wider Scouting community and agrees to proceed with his appointment to the Panel.
- Welcomed the **recommendation** to strengthen support to our Member Organizations via WOSM Services and raise awareness on the work done and support available in the areas of Impact of Scouting and Organisational Resilience.
- Approved the Sustainable Events Checklist and the checklist to choose new offices developed by the Sustainable Region Team.
- Welcomed, in view of the new triennium and the renewed efforts in the External Relations area of work, the **review of the European Scout Region's memberships in external platforms**; and in line with the Advocacy Strategy approach early this year, agreed to the prioritisation of the analysis of the value of elected positions in these platforms, based on past and current results and including a review of financial impacts.
- Approved the proposed process and format of the next Open Call – Regional Volunteer Pool 2025-2028.
- Endorsed the **bidders for the 26th European Scout Conference (2028)**, which will be released in the next (June) Conference Circular.
