Local Actions

This funding opportunity is part of the [Voices of Change project](#), which is organised in partnership with the Erasmus Student Network (ESN) and the World Scouting (WOSM). The project is funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union.

What is a Local Action?

As part of *Voices of Change*, young people can obtain a micro-grant to design and implement a Local Action, such as an initiative that aims to create a positive change in their local reality, and to empower communities to address peace and Human Rights Education.

General requirements

For your Local Actions to be considered, they need to:

1. Be organised in person (online activities are not accepted).
2. Be organised within a small team of young people (18-30 years old).
3. Take place in your local context: your town, your neighbourhood, your national scout association, ESN section, etc.
4. It can be a one-time event or a series of activities across more days.
5. Tackle one of the following topics:
 - Peacebuilding
 - Diversity and Inclusion
 - Humanitarian Action
 - Civic engagement
 - Human Rights

Timeline

Deadline to submit your application: 28 February 2026.

Results on the selection process will be shared in March 2026.

Local Actions must take place between **March and July 2026**.

They can last one or more days, depending on your project idea.

In March 2026, selected candidates will:

- Sign a **written agreement** and
- Attend an **online coaching session** where we will provide more information on managing their projects and reporting on their results and expenses. More information will be shared as we get closer to the date.

How can I apply?

To apply for funding to implement a Local Action, you need to:

1. Complete the [Local Action application form](#). The application must be **in English**.
2. Download a copy and complete the [Project Plan and Budget Excel](#). You will be able to upload the completed Excel file to the application form.
3. Provide a valid **International Commissioner endorsement** (only for Scouts). You will be able to upload the endorsement letter to the application form.



\$ Budget, reimbursement, and eligible costs

Budget

You can apply for a minimum of 500 EUR and a maximum of 1000 EUR.

Successful applicants will be required to provide the bank details for their Scout or ESN organisation, where the funding will be transferred. No funding will be transferred to private accounts.

Reimbursement

Reimbursements are based on **real costs**. This means that, if a successful project costs less than originally planned, the unspent funding must be returned to World Scouting or ESN. More information will be provided to successful candidates.
